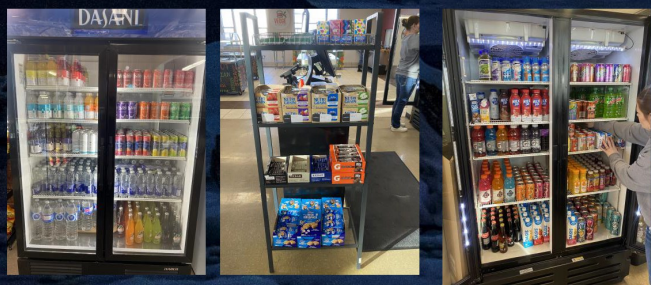
News from the Cafe

What the café' retail is offering.

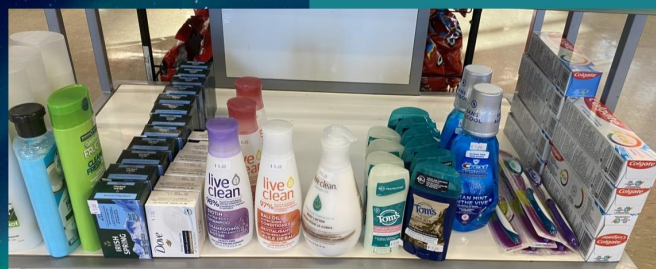
We have always offered snacks, drinks and grab and go. But in the last few months we have expanded our retail offerings. As you will see in the photos provided.



In these photos you can see that we continue to carry many of the students' favorites. Including caffeine free soft drinks, Bottled juices and water, candy, salty snack, protein bars and granola. We did streamline the options by selling out any of the items that didn't seem to be popular with our guests.
