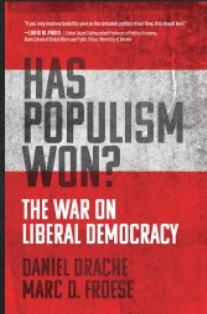

The War on Liberal Democracy**
by Daniel Drache & Marc D. Froese

Marc D. Froese is Professor of Political Science and the Founding Director of the International Studies Program at Burman University. He researches the intersection of politics, law and economics, with an emphasis on the political economy of trade, globalization, and populism. He has written four books and has published widely in scholarly journals in Europe, Asia, and North America. Professor Froese's newest book traces the electoral rise of authoritarian populist movements around the world. 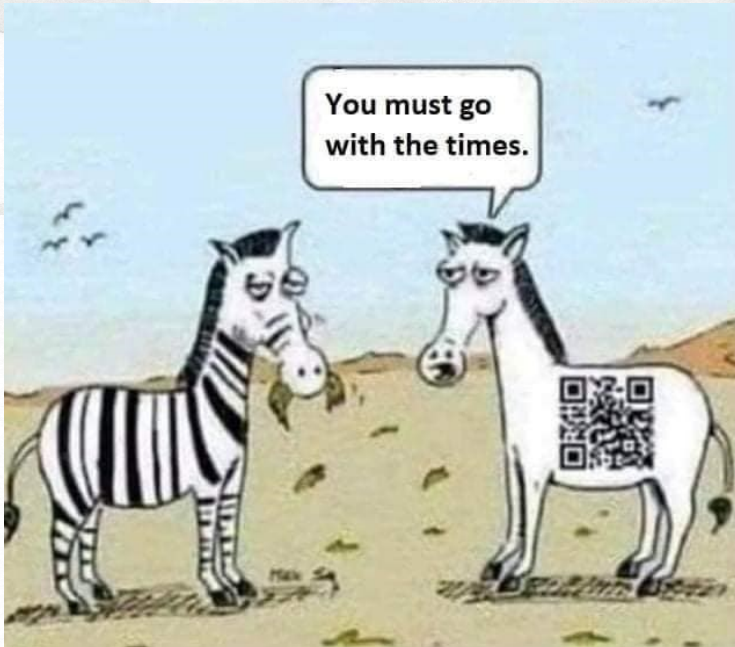
