Assembly & Week in Spiritual Emphasis Programming

Assembly meetings, which include Student Association meetings, Student Success Seminars, Community Worship or presentations by unexpected guest speakers, are included in the academic program to enable students to receive useful information that will enrich their academic, spiritual and future life. All students who are taking nine or more credits are charged a \$45.00 programming fee within the Mandatory Fee each semester. Students attending the 11 o'clock Tuesday and Thursday meetings in the Administration Building Chapel/Auditorium (as scheduled in the *Calendar of Events*) will receive \$5.00 credit for each meeting they attend, up to a maximum of \$45.00, at the end of each term.

One *Week in Spiritual Emphasis* is scheduled each semester. These meetings reinforce the vision, mission and core values of our school and because they are so important they have been scheduled during academic time. Regular attendance of all students, faculty and staff is definitely encouraged. Refer to the Revised Class Schedule for WISE in the current *Calendar of Events*.

Campus offices are requested to close during all spiritual programming including Opening Convocation, Community Worship, and WISE meetings.

All requests for seminars, student presentations or guest speakers must be submitted to the VP Student Services for orderly coordination of events.
